

OFT - PRIVACY POLICY & COOKIES

July 9, 2017

This document was written in Portuguese (PT). In situations where any translated version of this agreement contradicts the Portuguese version, it is the Portuguese version that prevails.

OFT collects information about you when you use our mobile applications, sites and other products and services online (collectively, the "Services") and through other interactions and communications you establish with us.

This Statement applies to persons who use our application or Services to view or share audiovisual content or interact with others ("Users").

OFT respects the legislation regarding the protection of privacy and the processing of personal data, namely Law 67/98, of October 26, with the amendments contained in Law no. 103/2015, of 24/08, and As of Law 41/2004 of 18 August in the wording of Law 46/2012 of 29 August.

1. Data control

OFT is the entity responsible for the collection and processing of personal data collected during use and / or registration on this site.

1.1 Information you provide to us

We collect the information you provide to us directly, such as when you create, modify, or sign in to your account, when you ask for support, consent to a background check, or when you communicate with us for other reasons. This information may include: name, taxpayer number, email, telephone number, postal address, profile picture, payment information, and other information you may provide at your option.

1.2 Information we collect through your use of our services

When you use our Services, we collect information about you in the following general categories:
Use information and preferences: We collect information about you and the site visitors interact with our Services, preferences indicated and chosen settings. In some cases, we do this through the use of cookies, pixel tags, and similar device identification technologies that create and maintain unique identifiers

Information about the devices: We may collect information about your mobile device, including, for example, hardware model the, the operating system and version, the preferred language, the unique identifier of the device, advertising identifiers, serial number, information About device movements and information about the mobile network.

Registration information: When you interact with services, we collect records Which may include information such as the IP address of the device, dates and times of access, application features or pages viewed, application failures and other system activity, Internet browser type, and the third party site or service , That you were using before interacting with our Services.

1.3 Important information about platforms' permissions

Most mobile platforms (iOS, Android, etc.) have defined certain types of device data that applications cannot access without their consent. And these platforms have different authorization systems to obtain their consent. The iOS platform will alert you to the first time the application of the OFT wants permission to access certain types of data and will allow you to consent (or disallow) this request.

1.4 Information from other sources associated with the information we collect through our Services.

If you choose to make a connection, create or sign in to your OFT account with a payment provider (e.g. Google Wallet) or social networking service (for example, Facebook), or if you use a separate application or site that Uses our API (or whose API we use), we may receive information about you or your links from that site or application.

1.5 Purpose of treatment

The OFT sites aim to serve as a platform for linking athletes, fans and sports brands according to their terms of use.

This information can be used to process online purchases, as well as to develop mechanisms for customizing the site.

The collection of personal data thus has the purpose of managing the contractual relationship, provision of services contracted, adaptation of services to the needs and interests of the Customer, information actions, marketing, in particular sending unsolicited communications for marketing purposes Through the use of automated calling and communication systems not dependent on human intervention (automatic calling machines), fax machines or electronic mail. When sending unsolicited electronic communications see the information below.

You may, however, make personal data available to us for other purposes, such as for the purposes of sending complaints and suggestions, disseminating OFT information, publicizing campaigns, promotions, advertising and news about OFT products and / or services, As well as for conducting market surveys, evaluation surveys.

To access the services and information to be made available on this site, it is mandatory to provide the requested data, since without them it is impossible to provide the services requested.

1.6 Recipients of personal data

The personal data collected are intended to be used by OFT for the purposes described above.

2. Right of access

After registration, the user has the right to access information about his / her data, to rectify it if it is not correct, or to erase it all according to the terms of article 11 of Law 67/98 of 26 October in its updated version.

3. unsolicited electronic communications

By accepting this Privacy Policy, you are authorizing the OFT in advance and expressly to send unsolicited communications for direct marketing purposes, namely through the use of automated call and communication systems that are not dependent on human intervention (automatic calling devices) , Fax machines or electronic mail, including SMS (short message services), EMS (enhanced messaging services), MMS (multimedia messaging services) and other similar types of applications.

4. Cookies

The cookies used by OFT respect anonymity and will not be used to collect any personal information.

5. Collection of data on open networks

6.1 Sending messages to the OFT website
